JOB SUMMARY: This position is responsible for assisting with cleaning duties needed to prepare aquarium for guests. While performing the essential functions of this position, the individual has regular contact with employees and guests.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Custodial work including daily tasks and large cleaning projects.
- Grounds keeping: assist with snow removal, maintaining landscaped areas, and cleaning around facility grounds.
- Able to use equipment such as floor scrubbers a scissor lifts to clean.
- Positively interact with guests, volunteers and staff.
- Handle emergency cleaning and upkeep requests.
- All other duties as assigned by supervisor.
- Ability to work well and efficiently under minimal supervision.
- Strong attention to detail.

The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.
