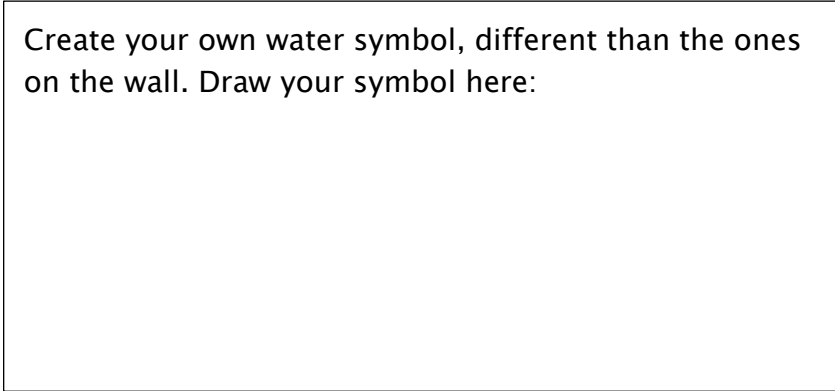

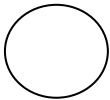
The water wall in the lobby has pictures or symbols that mean water.

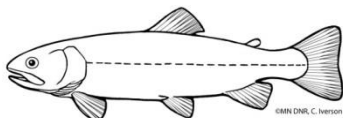
ANIMALS AROUND LAKE SUPERIOR




HABITAT COMPARISON










